

Cleveland State University College of Education and Human Services Cleveland Teaching Fellowship

2022-2023

The Cleveland Teaching Fellowship (CTF) includes partnerships between the Cleveland Metropolitan School District (CMSD), Cleveland State University and the Cleveland Foundation as well as Breakthrough Public Schools (BPS) and Cleveland State University. These grant programs engage highly qualified teacher candidates in **PAID** practicum and student teaching experiences in select CMSD and BPS buildings. With a national teacher shortage, CTF is creating a pipeline of strong teacher candidates committed to urban education.

Qualifications:

- Declared undergraduate, post-baccalaureate, or graduate major/license within the College of Education and Human Services in Special Education (Mild/Moderate, Moderate/Intensive, ECIS), Middle Childhood Education, Early Childhood Education, Adolescent Young Adult (Mathematics, Science, Language Arts, Social Studies), Foreign Language: French/Spanish, Music, Physical Education, or Speech Language Pathology
- Meet all academic and non-academic requirements necessary for Fall 2022 practicum experience (ATI, Internship I, etc.) and Spring 2023 student teaching (ATII, Internship II, etc.); including but not limited to GPA requirements, TaskStream, EdTPA, FBI/BCI, disposition, etc.
- US citizen or permanent resident
- Commitment to urban education
- Good academic standing

2022-2023 Fellows will:

- Commit to one academic year in the Cleveland Metropolitan School District or Breakthrough Public School
 District. Placements may be year-long or split between two schools. This includes 180 hours in Fall and 450
 hours in Spring 2023 (at least 13 weeks) *
- Participate in professional development sessions and program meetings
- Create deeper relationships with students, teachers, and administration beyond traditional experiences
 - Be involved outside of the classroom, including building PD sessions, extracurricular activities, student groups, etc.
- Participate in Shadow Days in and outside districts
- Receive up to \$6,300 over the academic year, potentially eliminating need for outside employment

 - Submit faculty, mentor, supervisor or employer Recommendation (letter or link: https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/CTFLOR2223) by FRIDAY, APRIL 1, 2022.
- Individuals will be invited to an interview to discuss programs and fit
