



The CSU GO Online Parking System allows CSU Students, Faculty and Staff to manage their parking accounts 24/7! Purchase permits, manage vehicles, view letters, etc. Campus Visitors have the ability to create a guest account on the system and register their vehicle. By using the CSU GO Online Parking System, CSU Students, Faculty and Staff choose where they want to park based on their personal budgets. CSU has several products available, including prepaid permits, and hourly and short-term parking at Pay Stations, coin meters, and in automated garages.

Interested in a Pre Paid Permits?

Choose a **White, Green, Evening** or **Night Permit** and you may park in any lot associated with that permit.

Here's how the parking system works:

- ➤ White Permits provide access to non-core, perimeter parking (including access to the South Garage by swiping your Viking Card).
- > Green Permits provide access to core parking and the South Garage (swipe Viking Card).
- Night & Evening Permits provide access to core and non-core lots and garages after specific times (except South Garage, Prospect Garage and Visitor lots).
- > Pre Paid Permits for Prospect Garage (PG) will be restricted to:
 - a) a limited number of students living in a University residence hall
 - b) a limited number of employees.

Where to buy permits

CSU Prepaid parking permits should be purchased via the CSU GO Online Parking System: **csuparking.T2hosted.com**. Simply login with your CSU ID and password. Permit sale dates: Aug. 1, Dec. 1 and April 1.

- ➤ Employees may pay by credit card* or payroll deduction as the payment method. *Visa, MC and Discover are accepted for payment via the CSU GO Line Parking System.
- Daily/hourly parking will be accepted at Central Garage (East 21st only): South Garage and Prospect Garage. (EG and WG after 3pm pm weekdays and Saturday and Sunday).
- Short-term parking is available in various locations at digital Pay Stations: Lot 22 (Student Center), Rec Garage (RG), Lot 70, Lot 66, Lot 54, Lot 20, Lot 21 and Lot 40. Patrons may also purchase through the PassPort Parking mobile app for a small service fee. csuohio.edu/parking/passport-parking
- Green and White permits are valid for parking in designated parking locations from 5:00 am 11:59 pm daily. Evening and Night permits are restricted to the time listed on the permit.



U-Pass

This program allows all eligible CSU students taking one or more credit hours on the main campus to save money on transit fare, as well as on parking and gas money. Students are automatically charged the fee on their Student Account for a U-Pass, which is good for unlimited rides on RTA for an entire semester. **Don't forget that most RTA buses have bike racks!**

The Bike Rack welcomes bicyclists with the convenience of secure bicycle parking and fulfilling everyday commuting needs with individual shower/changing facilities, lockers, bicycle rentals and a full-service bicycle repair shop.
