Ms. Whiting is also a top attorney in Cleveland, having founded her

own law firm and practicing law for more than 30 years; she was recognized by Northern Ohio Live as one of this area's top 100 lawyers for the impactful work she has done in economic and community development.

Ms. Whiting earned a B.S. in public policy from Duke University, a M.S in urban affairs and public policy from Southern Illinois University and a J.D. from the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign.

She currently serves as the Chair of the Board of Trustees of The MetroHealth System and is a member of the Tri-C Foundation Board of Trustees, the Cleveland United Way Board of Directors and the Olympic Steel Board of Directors. Ms. Whiting also serves on Governor DeWine's Business Advisory Committee for COVID-19 and is a member of the Restaurant Advisory Committee for COVID-19.

Whiting is a Life Member of the NAACP, and a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. She was named the Black Professional of the Year for 2019 by the Black Professional Association Charitable Foundation.
